What Does the Lord Have in Store for You in 2020?

The answer is in God's Word. In John 10:10 Jesus says, "I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly." The Lord's plan is that people experience the abundant life that he provides in a close relationship with him.

We must then read his Word. What is your Bible-reading plan for 2020? If your present plan is working, that's wonderful. If not, find one! Someone shared a plan that I've adopted. Read about five psalms a day, according to the day of the month. On the first of the month read Psalm I, 3I, 6I,9I and I2I. On the second day of the month, read Psalm 2, then keep adding thirty. Follow the pattern and also read in the other Bible books. Look for what God has to say to you. If I am listening, I hear him speak to me every day.

We must listen to what God is saying, and obey. Often I read in the Psalms and other Scriptures that I must seek God. This is really something to deal with. Seeking God changes you. It makes life different to seek the Lord. We begin to know that life is all about him. Further, Jesus said, "that they may have life."

We must remember that others need the abundant life Jesus offers. This reality should impact our desire to hear God, to listen to him, to love and pray for those who need him, and be looking to share the love of Jesus with others. Let's not miss what the Lord has in store for us this year!
