SUMMER CHOICES

What are your plans this summer? We have many choices during the summer months. A great choice is to participate in Vacation Bible School. Many of us came to Christ through Vacation Bible School. A few days ago ten ministers were together. As we talked, we found that two of them became believers through VBS. We all can participate in VBS: some by serving, others by going and each of us by praying!

Another choice is to go or support others who go on a mission trip. As I write this, one church has members on mission to Panama. Another church is doing mission week in Tennessee. In a few days I will join with about a dozen others to go on a mission trip to a town in the Appalachian mountains of Kentucky. Others are on mission elsewhere, or planning to go. Ken Frederick, pastor of Blackville First, is leaving for an extended mission trip to further efforts to reach an unreached people group, the Quilombolas in Brazil. This is the unreached people group for which many of us are praying. If you are not going, thank you for being supportive and praying.

SERVE impacts our area in late June. Youth and leaders do local missions with a servant's heart in the name of Jesus. I have seen them in action...and the evening worship times have been amazing!

In July, folks will be coming from many places to serve the people of Allendale in the name of Jesus through BRICK. I appreciate the nine churches that have stepped forward to feed lunch to those who will be doing construction missions. We have lunch covered! Now, we need many more people involved in praying for this outreach. Will you join us in praying that God will change lives through this mission effort?

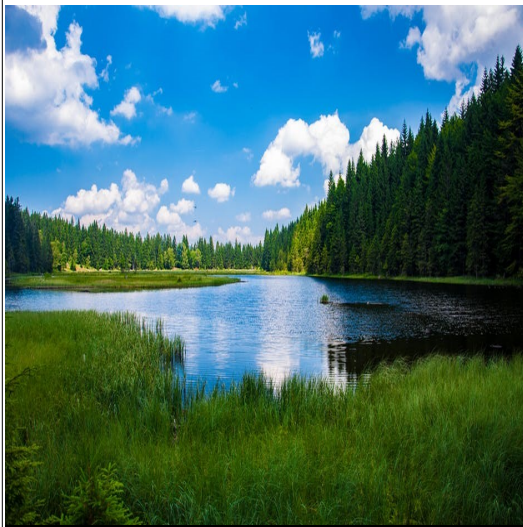
