Personalizing the Nursing Home Experience: a Support-Givers Guide

How it Has Helped Me

As you may know, nearly all visits to nursing homes were cut off for about a year due to Covid-19. I could not give my ninety-year-old mother a hug for over a year. Just recently visits have resumed on a limited basis. I learned several ways I can make visits more meaningful for my mother.

The chapter on providing stimulating activities helped me see a number of new ways I could make each visit more rewarding to Mom. The chapter on meaningful gifts gave me several ideas about what to bring to Mom. The chapter on emotional and spiritual awareness was full of suggestions that could bless Mom. I learned several ways to be a better support-giver.

How this Support Givers Guide Could Help You

The chapters I already mentioned can help anyone improve their nursing home ministry or visitation. And it is almost time for nursing home ministries to get restarted. But this book is also the clearest, most practical and wisest guide for families who may need to put a family member in a facility. It is a great guide from preparing for this change, to considerations for selecting a facility, to how to work with the facility as a support-giver, to a tremendous checklist as you compare different facilities, and more.

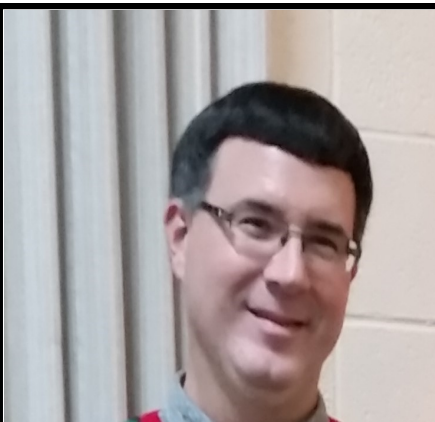
