ABC Regional Hispanic Ministries Report

Do you know what it is to be spiritually blind? The Apostle Paul describes this condition in his second letter to the Corinthians. He speaks of Jewish people who hear the Scriptures read but fail to see Christ in them, because they have a veil over their eyes. Then he says this: but whenever a person turns to the Lord, the veil is removed. (2 Corinthians 3:16 CSB) In the same way, many of the folks with whom we share the Gospel are spiritually blind to their need for a relationship with Christ. They have seen images of him and heard about what he's done, but there is a veil that keeps them from understanding that they can have a personal relationship with him. Their faith is based on images rather than the Word. Only the power of God can remove that veil. Would you join me in praying that many Spanish-speaking folks would come to understand the love of Christ? We Must Be Different

True Repentance

I recently had a conversation with a gentleman that reminded me of a basic doctrine that is readily overlooked. The subject of repentance is seldom discussed as well as preached. Yet, throughout the Bible repentance is mentioned and mandated. In Luke 13:3, Jesus states, "But unless you repent, you too will all perish." (NIV)

Hence, Christians must understand that repentance is essential to salvation. Yet, many people will conclude that they have a belief in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. However, one must conclude what has He saved us from? The answer would be the consequences of our sin. Romans 6:23 concludes, "For the wages of sin is death". (NIV) If one's sin results in eternal separation from God, then somehow one needs to be redeemed.

Even though one needs to be saved from one's sin, they must acknowledge their sin and remove themselves from sinful behaviors and circumstances. Yet, to live in sinful behavior is in direct contradiction of Biblical standards. IJohn 1:10 states, "If we claim we have not sinned, we make him(Christ) out to be a liar and his word has no place in our lives." (NIV) From this Biblical source, it is required for all believers to repent of their sins in order to have the appropriate relationship with Christ.

Still, some may ask, "What is true repentance?" Repentance is based on a term which means to change one's intended course into an opposite direction. This change will be focused upon a standard that is shown through Christ's life and standards. From these Biblical sources, it concludes that it is imperative for repentance to be at the center of a believer's life.


